Charles Street Busway Upgrades

Night work on Charles Street and Bus Stop Relocation

The Charles Street Bus Bridge and Busway Project is being delivered by Main Roads on behalf of the Public Transport Authority (PTA). The project will provide a long term solution to improve bus transport into the city and ease traffic congestion.

Charles Street Progress

Work is underway at various locations in Northbridge, and is progressing on Charles Street.

The west-side of Charles Street will soon be resurfaced, and the Ivy Street bus stop will be relocated 120m to the north of its existing location.

Night work

From Monday 21 November, there will be intermittent night works to lay asphalt. Work will occur for up-to three nights in the weeks beginning 21 November and 28 November.

During this period lanes will be modified to accommodate the work. Traffic management will be in place to guide road users through the works area.

These activities will be happening on Charles Street, between Newcastle and Janet Street. Access into Ivy Street will be maintained, but there may be short periods of disruption. This will be controlled with traffic management on-site.

We will endeavour to minimise noise and vibration as much as possible and will be working within the limits of the project's noise and vibration management plan.

Night-work will take place between 8pm and 7am.

The existing bus stop which is located at Ivy Street (bus stop number 12599) will be moving approximately 120m to the north-side of Janet Street.

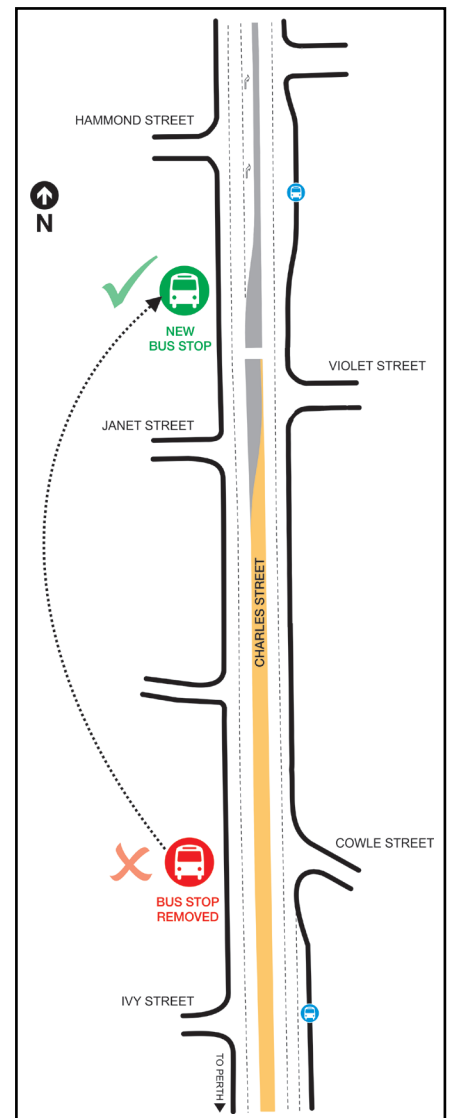
